Intro Question

Do you ever feel pressure to “pray well”? How can we become more comfortable praying “messy prayers”?

Going Further Questions

Read Jonah chapter 2. What stands out to you? What questions does it raise?

What do you think is the significance of seeing the great fish as something God provided?

What do we learn about Jonah from this prayer?

Do you think Jonah repents in this prayer?

Jonah says that God hurled him into the depths. This is similar to some Psalms (like Psalm 88:6). How would you feel about praying to God like this during hard times?

Reflection Question

For this last question, you don't need to share your answer with others unless you are comfortable doing so.

Take a moment to reflect on God's character as one who responds to messy prayers. Is God inviting you to pray a bold but messy prayer to him? (This doesn't mean now, it may be something you do privately).
